

LoJack SCI InTransit Recoveries – Commercial (Cargo)

LoJack[®] SCI InTransit[™] provides a covert tracking and monitoring solution that actually recovers stolen cargo and other mobile assets. It also provides intangible benefits, including real time information and chain of custody monitoring for goods in transit, and helping law enforcement fight the problem of cargo and vehicle theft—which aids police in combating organized crime rings and getting wanted criminals off the streets. But most important, LoJack SCI InTransit helps protect both the supply chain and a company's bottom line. Following are some examples of LoJack SCI InTransit in action.

Commercial Recoveries

Case 1

In the early morning hours several masked men overpowered a tractor-trailer driver at gunpoint outside the gates of the destination Distribution Center in Brampton, ON, Canada. The thieves disabled the truck's GPS and hijacked the rig—taking the tobacco products and the driver with them. Eventually the driver was released and notified authorities. The Peel Regional Theft Task Force was able to follow the signal from the **LoJack SCI InTransit** multi-mode tracking device embedded in the load, to the facility believed to be connected with the crime and obtain a search warrant.

Results - Seven arrests of a known cargo theft gang

- Full load of tobacco products recovered
- \$2 million in additional cargo recovered from previous hijackings

Case 2

A theft-in-progress alert was received from the **LoJack SCI InTransit** tracking device when a shipment deviated from its designated route. Local law enforcement, state police and a multistate task force were immediately deployed. The well-coordinated surveillance effort resulted in warrants for two locations.

Results – Five arrests

- \$835,000 load recovered
- \$1.25 million worth of other stolen merchandise found

Case 3

Federal law enforcement resolved a case involving an Ecuadorian gang suspected of stealing over 30 trailer loads of a six-month period. Using **LoJack SCI InTransit** tracking device and Web-mapping technology, “virtual perimeter and route fence” were created with real-time tracking alerts.

Results – Four arrests

- \$1.2 million of cargo recovered
- One subject turned informant led to recovery of additional stolen merchandise and arrests

Case 4

A California task force tracked and located a stolen trailer load of electronics using two chase cars. The suspects deployed their own counter surveillance through 60 miles of heavy traffic and construction zones. Using **LoJack SCI InTransit**, Law enforcement was able to maintain real-time, online “stand back” visibility of the stolen trailer and cargo.

Results – Four arrests

- Full load of electronics recovered
- \$1.4 million worth of other stolen merchandise found

Case 5

Four armed men wearing ski mask robbed a load of cigarettes at a trucking facility in Waxahachie, Texas. Two men held up the guards while the other two men hot-wired a tractor-trailer and disabled its GPS. The monitoring center was able to track the vehicle using the **LoJack SCI InTransit** tracking device in the cargo and assist local law enforcement to the vehicle location.

Results – Four arrests

- Full load value at \$1 million recovered within one hour of robbery

Case 6

A well-known cosmetic company's 19-pallet shipment was stolen en route from Chicago to Miami. Within 24 hours of being notified of the theft, **LoJack SCI InTransit** monitoring specialist provided the location of the cargo to law enforcement. The load was found within 30 feet of where the tracking device indicated it would be.

Results – One arrest

- \$150,000 worth of stolen cargo recovered

Case 7

California Highway Patrol – Cargo Theft Interdiction Program (CTIP) used the **LoJack SCI InTransit** tracking device on a suspect's vehicle. The reporting rate was set for extended surveillance and the suspects were monitored for five days.

Results – One arrest and recovery of a loaded unregistered handgun

- 3 stolen loads estimated at approximately \$200,000
- GE appliances and 2 loads of blankets

Case 8

A covert sting operation conducted by Travelers Insurance Investigators, the NCIB, and Illinois State Police (ILSP) Law Enforcement involved equipping the sting trailer with a **LoJack SCI InTransit** tracking device and monitoring the trailer and the cargo. The targets were known cargo theft organized gangs. The operation involved tracking and monitoring the truck, trailer, cargo to a warehouse where the goods would be stored until they could be sold.

After receiving an alert, the ILSP began following the trailer. It stopped at a warehouse location where the one pallet of planted merchandise was unloaded by thieves. The truck and trailer continued on and was stopped by police and driver was arrested. The police were able to get a search warrant for the warehouse where the pallet was dropped. In addition to the driver arrest and tractor/trailer recover the, search warrant for the warehouse yielded the planted merchandise and additional stolen goods including some from a previous Travelers loss.

Results – several arrests

- Several million dollars in recovered cargo
